



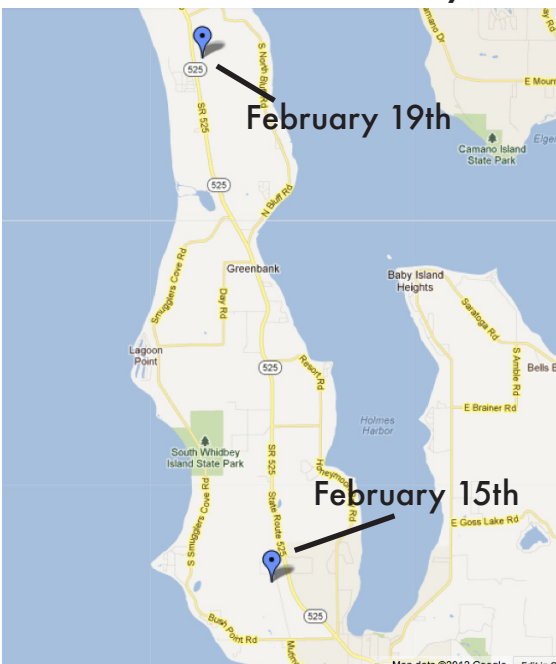
Rescheduled growing groceries



Fruit Tree Pruning

This is a basic class for those who have little or no experience in dormant fruit tree pruning. The primary focus will be pruning fruit trees, including young trees, for structure and yield; mitigation pruning in neglected fruit trees and lowering the canopy without topping. There will be a short lecture followed by a demonstration and an opportunity to practice (weather permitting).
